He was awarded his PhD degree from the University of Athens Medical School in 2015. Furthermore he was awarded with a scholarship in Lung Cancer Diagnosis and Treatment Modalities, from Hellenic Thoracic Society in 2015. He was specialized in interventional pulmonology in Royal Brompton Hospital and Imperial College London where he was trained in Bronchoscopy and its novel applications to Respiratory Medicine, Bronchoscopic Lung Volume Reduction for emphysema with devices like endobronchial valves and endobronchial coils. He was involved in Bronchial Thermoplasty for Asthma Treatment. He is currently performing a range of procedures including EBUS, Radial US Miniprobe for detection of peripheral lung tumors, Cryotherapy – Cryoablation – Cryobiopsy for ILD Diseases and the insertion of metallic coated or uncoated and silicone stents through flexid or rigid bronchoscope. He is active in both research and clinical tasks. He has 12 papers published in International Medical Journals.
