

Dr. Dirk-Jan Slebos, MD PhD, is pulmonary physician and interventional bronchoscopist at the University Medical Center Groningen, The Netherlands. He has extensive experience in interventional bronchoscopy, and has his main clinical and research focus on the development of innovative bronchoscopic treatments for patients with COPD. He leads the UMC -Groningen bronchoscopic intervention program, a high volume program with over 500 tertiary patient referrals annually, with annually 100 lungvolume reduction procedures performed, using a number of different techniques and devices. At the University Medical Center Groningen he runs bronchoscopical intervention trials from very early first-in-human studies, to phase-3 trials, and published original work in all major pulmonary journals as well as JAMA, Lancet and NEJM. He has a well known experience in teaching new interventional techniques to colleagues in the field worldwide.
